Thank you for coming to Day 1 of SHARING REPTON at Kenwood in October 2018.

We hope you will join us for **Day 2 on Thursday 25th April 2019 from 11.00 – 14.00** which will be held at one of three garden squares in London designed by Humphry Repton: **Russell Square, Bloomsbury, London WC1B 5EH.** and then at **The Mary Ward Centre, Queen Square, WC1N 3AQ.**



At Russell Square we will tell you about the history of Russell Square (designed by Humphry Repton, who also designed some of the gardens at Kenwood), and show you some of the key features now in the Square.

You are then invited to:

EITHER

(i) view and plan for the planting of a Community Garden plot which will feature plants that are important to you, and share your knowledge of those plants (approx. 10 participants from all three groups).

OR

(ii) explore another nearby square and identify some of the key features you find there (*see Garden Features overleaf*). Groups of 4 - 5 people, together with one of our volunteers, will visit one of 5 local squares: Bloomsbury, Tavistock, Gordon, Queens or Brunswick.

We shall then move across the road to The Mary Ward Centre, a nearby adult education centre, where you will hear more about the various organisations that care for and enjoy London's parks and gardens, and how you could, if you wish, get involved.

Green spaces can include parks, gardens, squares, commons, housing estate grounds, hospital gardens, churchyards, cemeteries. Overleaf you will find details of some of the features you may find in your local park or garden.

Your travel expenses will be paid and tea/coffee at the start of the day and lunch will be provided.
